Physical Exam

Physical exams are currently required for students in grades K, 4, 7 & 11. Please send into the school nurse as soon as they are completed. Most children receive physical exams on a yearly basis. It is a good idea to send them to school as you get them. This way you always have an updated physical on file no matter what grade your child is in.


Watch Out for Lyme Disease

Lyme Disease is caused by a bacteria that is spread by tiny infected ticks (deer tick). Both people and animals can become infected with Lyme Disease. The disease is mostly spread between late May and early Autumn. Lyme Disease often begins with a red circular rash at the site of the tick bite. The rash can last for a few weeks, and may be accompanied by flu like symptoms such as headache, fever and muscle aches. If a circular rash appears seek medical attentions.

Kindergarten Immunizations

All students entering Kindergarten in September, 2018 must have on file with the school nurse all the required immunizations needed for school. If you do not, your child will be excluded on the first day of school. These requirements are state mandated and must be followed.

Also a current physical exam is required for all 2018 Kindergarten students. It must be on file with the school nurse no later than December 31, 2018.
