BUILDING USE CATERGORIES

A. SCHOOL-AFFILIATED ORGANIZATIONS/TOWN GOVERNMENT MEETINGS

This category includes all school-affiliated organizations and Town Government meetings.

Organizations include: PACs, Booster Club, Rockland Education Association, School Committee, Community Education, Summer School, School Athletics Teams, School Plays, Citizen Scholarship Foundation, Board of Selectmen, Finance Committee, Town Departments, Town Committees

B. CIVIC & YOUTH ORGANIZATIONS

This category includes civic organizations and organizations whose activities are a sole benefit to the youth of Rockland.

Organizations include: Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, Cub Scouts, Brownies, Camp Fire Girls, Youth Commission, Town Athletic Teams, North River Collaborative

C. ROCKLAND COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS

This category includes community and business organizations based in Rockland.

Organizations include: Business Groups, Service Clubs, Leisurewoods, Adult Athletic Groups, Churches

D. OUT-OF-TOWN ORGANIZATIONS

This category includes all other organizations not based in Rockland.

Outside Business Groups, Basketball Groups, Softball Groups, Unions, Clubs, Athletic Groups

*Caterers may use the kitchen, but not the dishes or utensils. At least one member of the cafeteria staff must supervise.

Use of school gymnasium does not include use of showers. **SHOWERS MAY NOT BE USED.

CUSTODIAL FEES:

It is necessary to charge ALL lessees the actual cost of custodians, matrons, and clean-up details where deemed necessary. In addition to the rental fees as listed above, the custodian's fees shall be a set rate and shall be a minimum of two hours per evening. Please keep in mind that it may be necessary for the custodian to spend time prior to, and after, an event for which he must be paid. Minimum fee must be paid if 24 hours notice has not been received prior to a cancellation.
